PDM Stresses Need To Win Over Indonesia To The Free World Camp

President Macapagal Thursday said that there exists an "identical struggle" between the free world and the communist camp to keep Indonesia from moving towards the communist side. "If Indonesia turns communist," President Macapagal said "the Philippines will be among the first to be adversely affected."

In his speech before the Manila Overseas Press Club, the President observed that the important factors of Indonesia's choice for closer relation were increased military collaboration with nations of the free world.

The President pointed out that the Philippines has joined in the effort of the free world to keep Indonesia from moving towards the communists.

The Chief Executive observed that the stakes are so enormous that "it is the Philippine view that as long as there is a single ray of hope of preventing Indonesia from moving to the communists, it is worth exerting the necessary patience to prevent it."

the concept of social justice so deeply rooted in our system.

One of the overriding considerations for the enactment of the Land Reform Code is the elimination of certain evils that have allegedly afflicted farm tenancy. The proposition animating the land reform program envisioned in this law may be framed as follows: A system is bad if there are evils in it; there are evils in farm tenancy; therefore, farm tenancy is bad, and must be abolished. The fallacy of the proposition is not hard to detect. A system is not necessarily bad if evils exist in its being. We do not just proceed to liquidate a person simply because he is full of ailments. Therefore, the abolition of share tenancy is not at all justified not only from the logical, but as previously pointed out, from the constitutional standpoint as well.

And the evils that have been attributed to tenancy by the proponents of the Land Reform Code as a justification for its abolition, suffice it to say that historically, and by regulatory measures enacted by the legislature, our tenants all over the country have improved their lot thru the years. We have for instance Republic Act 1199, otherwise known as the Agricultural Tenancy Act, which regulates among others the relationship between landowners and tenants and which give the tenant the freedom to determine for himself the status under which he can best improve his lot.

It is an undeniable fact that the tenants have gone a long way since Spanish time in enhancing their well-being. They are now protected by law—laws designed to prevent their exploitation by unscrupulous landowners. This shows the inherent strength of the democratic way of life, its flexibility in bringing about desirable adjustments in society, and in making room and provision for progress among all classes of the body politic. In fact, the so-called evils of tenancy have gradually vanished thru evolutionary transformation to a more harmonious relationship between landowners and tenants. Such relationship has developed into a close-knit, cooperative and productive partnership. The Land Re-

form Code seeks to put the landowners aside and give way to the government to take over.

Now the question: Is the government a suitable substitute tenants? Can the government's active and direct participation in the agricultural development of the nation—known only in dictatorial countries—be as personal, intimate and productive as that supplied by the landowner? Can the government feel the same way as the landowner had developed for his tenants? Finally, is the government financially prepared to absorb, and assume full responsibility over the more than one million tenants in the country who are now being taken care of by landowners whose number far exceeds that of the government agencies intended to replace them? What happens to the poor tenant when the government neglects to attend to him, especially during off-election years or probably, decides to abandon him for lack of funds?

 and finally on May 19, 1434,
 as they removed a big stone,

 mon Vela's wound in the
 head was instantly cured;
 Pascual Sanchez' defect in
 the eye disappeared; Juan

 and finally, Benito Sanchez'
 finger which was defective
