

Airial View Of The Interscholastic Village In Pili



Above will be the airial View of the 7-hectare Interscholastic Village in Pili, Camarines Sur when completed. The main 2-storey concrete grandstand (A) is now about 50 % finished. While the 2 semi-permanent bleachers (B & C) are almost 80 % completed. The Track and field oval (D) is about 90 % finished, and the swimming pool and bleachers (E & F) are approximately 35 and 65 % completed respectively.

The whole athletic complex will be ready for use one week before the start of the meet, March 16-22, 1969. All of these are made possible with a total outlay of P1,200,000 frcm National (P900T) and provincial (P300T) funds. It is considered to be the Major accomplishment of the Cledera Administration during its first year in Office.
