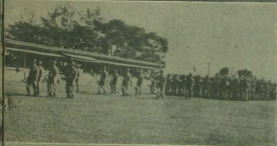

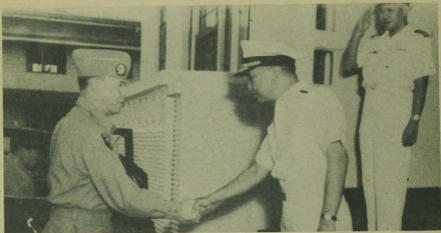
Hail to the Commander-in-Chief

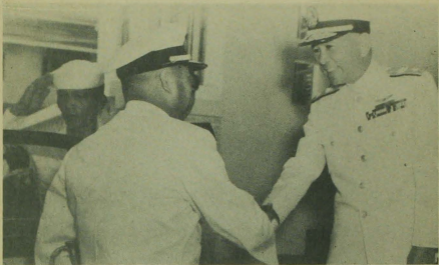

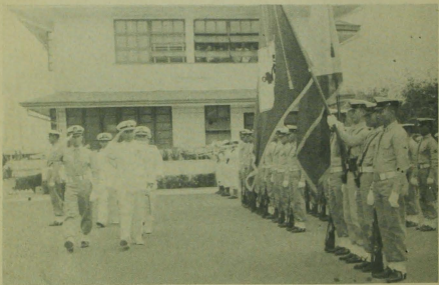

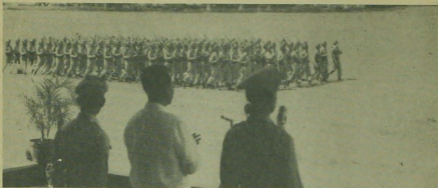


3rd Division Trainees
