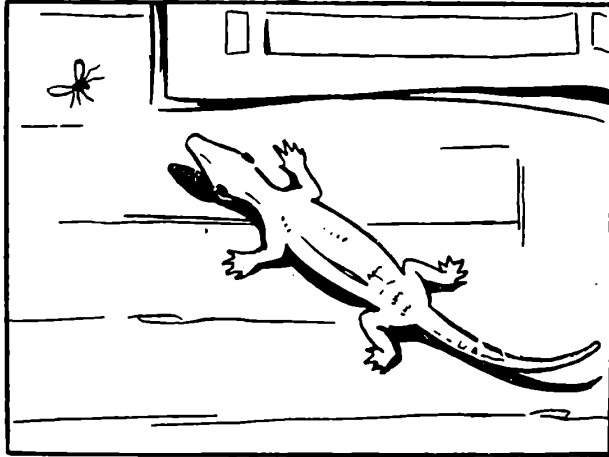


FOR SECOND GRADERS**MY LITTLE LIZARD FRIEND**
