#### Second Site For Rice Production Project Selected

Rice and Corn Production Rice and Corn Production Coordinating Council (RCP-CC) has selected the Binahasa-Tabak area in Leyte Norte as the site of the second rice production and extention project, President Marcos was informed recent

The site was recommended by the joint Filipino-Chinese Team after conducting a survey of the area and favorably endorsed by Vice President and concurrently Secretary of Agriculture Fernando Lopez.

The implementation of the project will be undertaken by the Filipino-Chinese Agricultural Technical teams patterned after the Baliung project.

The project site is lessed 18 kilometers west of Taciobas City with a spread of about 12 kilometers, slong the national lighter, slong the national lightery comprising Sta, Fe, parts of Palo, Pastrana and Ataga-Alang. It has a total acresge of over 10,000 bectures of which 2,400 hectares consist of irrigated rice paddies bounded by cocount plantations.

The survey team reported that the Psio clay loam, the type of soit found in the area, is considered suitable for cultivation of high yirlding rice varieties (HYVs).

The Binabaan-Tibal area is characterized by the absence of a dry season with a pronounced rainful from November to January.

The present average floe-yield in the area is from 40 to 42 cavens per hectare. With the introduction of HYVs, barvest is expected to average about 80-100 cavens p.r bectare.
