## PDM Stresses Need To Win Over Indonesia To The Free World Camp

President Macapagal Thursday said that there exists an "identical struggle" between the free world and the communist camp to keep Indonesia from moving towards the communist side.

In his speech before the Manila Overseas Press Club, the President observed that the important factors of Indonesia's choice for closer relation were increased military collaboration with nations of the free world.

The President pointed out that the Philippines has joined in the effort of the

free world to keep Indonesia from moving towards the communists.

"If Indonesia turns communist," President Macapagal said "the Philippines will be among the first to be adversely affected."

The Chief Executive observed that the stakes are so enormous that "it is the Philippine view that as long as there is a single ray of hope of preventing Indonesia from moving to the communists, it is worth exerting the necessary patience to prevent it."

## A Lady Newspaper Columnist Urges Further Development of Bikol Tourist Spots

Sorsogon, Sorsogon-A lady columnist of a metropolitan paper made a tour of the tourist spots in this province as part of a trip in the Bicol Region to gather materials for a series of articles on tourist spots of the Bicolandia.

Rita Gerona Adkins, who hailed from Bulan, Sorsogon, was accompanied by her husband Douglas and mother-in-law, Edith Adkins. According to Mrs. Adkins, the scenic spots she visited were the Rizal Beach, Buluan Lake Resort, Palhi spring resort, Masacrot Spring, Liked View, Irosin view around the fringe of the Hill-top church, Buenavista 17-hectare lake.
