PNR Gen. Manager Jimenez gives warning to people living near RR lines.

General Manager Nicamor T. Jimenez of the Philippine National Railways today warned people living within the vicinity of the PNR main tracks to exercise carefulness and alertness as the company increases the frequencies of train trips due to the recent arrival of new rolling stocks.

In his warning, Jimenez singled out those living in the barrios at the southern tip of Quezon and Camarines Sur provinces to stop using improvised rail skates, railbikes and other crude railcrafts on the PNR main lines.

Jimenez' action came in the wake of reports that accidents occurred in the lines mostly due to barrio folk's recklessness in riding on these "rolling coffins". He bewailed the fact that people living along the PNR main lines could and must cases approximate the arrivals of train which prompts them to use the rails with impunity.

Ever time there is an increase of train trips or a mere change of schedule of runs, accidents are most likely to happen, Jimenez observed.

The PNR head issued a stern directives to all track personnel to see that the railroad tracks of any improvised transport crafts. He also ordered the PNR police department to apprehend rail skate operators and to confiscate railbikes, railbikes and other railcrafts that are used on the railroad tracks.
