The first outdoor range of the NRPA was in the premises of the Philippine Vegetable Oil Company (about 100 yards from the present ranges) on Calle Pureza in Santa Mesa, alongside the Pasig river. The range was inaugurated on March 17, 1935, and a picture was taken of the officers and guests above (left to right): A. D. Hileman, Police Chief Columbus E. Piatt, Judge Delfin Jaranilla, president of the NRPA, City Fiscal Alfonso Felix, Attorney Campos and Lieut. Col. M. N. Castañeda of the Philarmy.
