

Taking a humanitarian view of the Huk problem, the President declared that the problem now existing in Central Luzon is essentially a social problem, caused by conditions of poverty and forced upon the people by the feudal terms of land tenure. As such, he said, it should be solved only by means of social action. The President stressed that these conditions can be changed only by "providing the poor of greater economic independence, better opportunities for education, and modern facilities for protection of their health."

Realizing these problems when he took over, the President said, that in June 1966, he launched the Central Luzon Development Program with the immediate goal of accelerating greater agricultural productivity. Some 26 government agencies are cooperating to achieve the objectives of the program.

The President reiterated the policy shift after his conference with Central Luzon provincial and municipal officials and APP officers, saying that the peace and order in Central Luzon is the primary responsibility of local leaders.
