New Finance Service Insigne

THE INSIGNE is of two (2) colors, silver and gold, basically of two (2) materials, brass (goldplated) as the base material and silver for the figure of the pearl (raised). The Finance Service insigne is composed of eight-scalloped mother-of-pearl - golden shell with one pearl embedded in it set on a golden laurel leaves.
