## New Finance Service Insigne

**T**HE INSIGNE is of two (2) colors, silver and gold, basically of two (2) materials, brass (gold-plated) as the base material and silver for the figure of the pearl (raised). The Finance Service insignie is composed of eight-scalloped mother-of-pearl — golden shell — with one pearl embedded in it set on a golden laurel leaves.

### Meaning and/or Significance

a. Shell stands for currency or medium of exchange on the one hand. On the other, it represents the Finance Service as the guardian of the finances of the AFP as the mother-of-pearl shell encloses a pearl.

b. The pearl symbolizes our country, the pearl of the Orient Seas.

c. Laurel leaves, golden, stand for honesty and integrity.

d. Golden color stands for gold, the universal standard of values.
