PHILIPPINE DELEGATION CHAIRMAN HOPES FOR "ONE WORLD" OF CULTURE

Mistrust between nations is the greatest threat to the concept of "one world", Senator Proceso Sebastian, chairman of the Philippines delegation to the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization.

Senator Sebastian proposed that to "help dispel the mistrust which complicates international relations, we propose the gradual adoption by all nations of a common medium of writing—at least for official purposes, he said.

"We also will propose publication of international newspaper, international radio broadcasts and exchange of students between universities of different nations.

"Above all, we want to show the world that small nations are willing to cooperate to create 'one world' from the standpoints of education, science and culture."

Members of the delegation that will leave for Paris are Francisco Ortega, speaker pro tem of the Philippine House of Representatives; Senator Salipada Pendatun, Dr. Gabriel Manalac, chairman of the National committee on Education, and Dr. Encarnacion Alzona, professor at the University of the Philippines.
