French fishermen admit defeat in week-long blockade

PARIS (AFP) — The crews at the port of Le Havre have conceded their strike and 16 ships admitted defeat and yesterday decided to end their week-long battle to blockade the vital oil port of Fos-sur-Mer as the French cabinet restated its aim to keep the country's main ports open.

But while fishermen in the south decided to end their skirmishing tactics following a clash with the French Navy last night in which four of their colleagues were slightly injured, trawlermen in the north continued to block shipping.

The channel port of Boulogne was paralyzed with fishermen's and lorry drivers blocking the road, and even hovercraft traffic was brought to a standstill and some companies diverted passengers to Calais.

A mass meeting was scheduled for later today in Boulogne, where fishermen's protest was launched over two weeks ago.

The government does not hesitate to put lives at risk." The French cabinet agreed at its weekly meeting to keep major ports open because "they are not concerned by the problems of the fishermen."

The government also said it regarded Dec. 31, 1980 as the deadline for agreement on a European Community policy covering all kinds of fish.

The government approved measures by transport minister Joel Thuillat to improve conditions for the fishing industry concerning regional studies of the problems facing inshore fishermen.

Customs amends overtime rates paid by clients to its staff

The Bureau of Customs has amended the regulations governing claims for overtime, traveling expenses, board and lodging and meal allowances and other expenses of customs officers payable by steamship and airline companies, importers, exporters and customs brokers.

According to a new administrative order, the overtime rates per hour are: P10 for the collector of customs (MIA); P12 for supervisors, appraisers, examiners, wharfingers, boarding officers, entrance and clearance officers and inspectors; P9; security guards, gate-

keepers and warehousemen (storekeepers) P8.

MEALS. Meal allowances will be P14 per meal for every category of customs officer. Meal allowances will be given if the overtime service falls during the following periods: breakfast from 6 a.m. to 8 a.m.; lunch from noon to 1 p.m.; supper from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. and midnight repast from 11 to 1 a.m.

Customs officers rendering overtime services at airports are entitled to midnight repast on all days. Customs officers performing underguarding service outside their official stations are entitled to meal allowances.

INVITATION FOR PREQUALIFICATION TO BID

All parties to bid for the ERECTION AND INSTALLATION OF 69 KV, 3-PHASE TRANSMISSION LINES (PART II) UNDER THE TAP-BANGUEN POWER LOAN PROJECT, are invited to prequalify for the forthcoming bidding thereof. Application for prequalification is open to any Philippine Construction Company registered with the Philippine Contractors Board for Contractors at least Category C and classified as General Engineering Contractors and/or Specialty Electrical Contractors.

The work involves the erection and installation of 69 KV Transmission Lines and is divided into two (2) schedules as follows:

Schedule I - 1. Bangued-Licuan 33.83 kms.
 2. Tap-Bangued-Manabo 22.40 kms.
 Schedule II - 1. Tap-Licuan-Baybaggao 3.42 kms.
 2. Camaligan-Gonzaga 33.44 kms.

Prospective bidders must submit, in three (3) copies the PREQUALIFICATION FORMS (PART III) duly accomplished and complete with all supporting documents required therein on or before October 1, 1980. All documents submitted in support of the Prequalification Bid will be considered strictly confidential. NAPOCOR will not accept or act on complete applications regarding other procedure or results of the Prequalification. Financing Fund required for this project shall be a refundable or duty executed instrument issuable by a reputable bank or financing institution acceptable to the Government stating that the bidder has established a credit line with the said bank or financing institution in the following amount:

India launches first training sail ship

NEW DELHI (AFP) — India yesterday began the first training sail ship to have its own sail training ship for the sea deck.

"Varuna," an 80-ton brig, was formally launched at Bhavnagar, on the western coast, by Phyllis Pereira, wife of the chief of the naval staff, Admiral Pereira, reports said.

The sail ship, built at the state-run Mazaan dock at Bhavnagar, was to provide training in seamanship and designed to provide education in other maritime skills such as navigation, communication and marine engineering.
